

HEATING INDUSTRY PROPOSAL TO LOWER

Under the Providence Resolution, the heating oil industry has established benchmarks to achieve net-zero emissions by 2050 using Bioheat® fuel.

CURRENT MANDATES

Under current law, RI requires blends of 5% biodiesel or renewable diesel in all heating oil for residential, commercial, or industrial uses.



The requirement increases to: • 10% by 2023 · 20% by 2025 • 50% by 2030

All heating fuel purchased by RI state agencies now contains at least 5% biofuel. All state agencies also can purchase 20% and 99% biodiesel blends.

> Rhode Island General Laws exempt biodiesel produced in state from the motor fuel excise tax

> > 2021 Act on Climate establishes greenhouse gas reduction mandates:

 45% below 1990 levels by 2030 • 80% below 1990 levels by 2040 net zero by 2050
